

# SCSEP GPMS

## Release Notes – Version 1.9

---

**Release Date: July 14, 2023**

GPMS Release 1.9 will address new features, Production data changes and bugs discovered during the previous release.

### New Features and Enhancements

- The Assignments by Host Agency (AHA) is now added to the list of available reports. Users can now view and download the report.

### Fixes

- Users can now enter the termination letter date independently of entering exit information.
- The system will now navigate users to the Checklist page when required fields are not populated for migrated data.
- The Right of Return warning message is updated to say “**A participant cannot exercise the right of return 90 days or more after exit date**”.
- Added last update date field to the Waiver Factor section of the Characteristics page.
- Populated the date field for SCSEP Employment Outcome measure (B2) with the actual date.
- The State is now included in the QPR header if the state is selected when generating the QPR.
- Measure revised to include all placements for the reporting period in D.2e Median Starting Wage in Placements.
- Removed the subtraction of Paid Training hours from Paid hours in the QPR Calculation
- Reformatted the QPR header to eliminate the word “Quarterly”
- Modified Section A of the QPR to display percentages without the decimal point, corrected the misalignment of the field “Female”, and word wrapped the contents of col C
- Realigned the Grant Overview section of the QPR to match the other columns in the QPR.
- Revised the label for D.3b(1) to “**Total Number of Participants Providing General Community Service**”
- Revised the label for D.3b(2) to “**Total Number of Participants Providing Elderly Community Service**”

- Change name of measure D.2c to "**Number of Records without Credit in the Second Quarter After Exit**"
- Revised Percentage of Placements with Benefits (D.2f) to look at the numerator and denominator counts at the placement level.
- Revised Average Hours per Weeks in Placement (D.2g) to include all non-self-employed placements for all placements.
- Removed 'Numerator' and 'Denominator' fields for B2.3 Median Earnings and add 'Count'
- Changed name of measure D.2c to "Number of Records without Credit in the Second Quarter After Exit"
- Reformatted the date on the PRA report to be consistent throughout the entire report.
- Transfer link is now available for the Program Analyst Role
- Fixed issue with Enrollment screen not saving changes to State and County fields.
- Fixed the issue where a user was unable to update the Host Agency contact information.
- Fixed the issue with users who did not have the correct option for Global Read Only role.
- Synchronized the Durational Limit Date (DLD) in the WDL report with the DLD on the participant record.
- Fixed the issue where previously entered Follow Up data is disappearing from the UI once Placement End Date is entered.
- Fixed the issue where Mailing Address change is not retained after saving.
- Fixed the issue where new Sub-Grantee was not being displayed in the Manage Sub-Grantee list.
- Durational Limit Date is now displaying correctly for participants who have exited for Durational Limit reason.
- Fixed the issue where Exit Date still appeared in Cases Search and Participant History after the Exit is deleted.
- Fixed the issue where no Assignments were populated under Transferred Assignments after a Transfer for some participants.
- Fixed the issue where the information in Extensions Tab and Related Actions>Manage Extensions view did not match.
- Fixed the issue where the Grantee Admin role was missing from the drop down allowing them to be assigned as a Supervisor.
- Program Analysts are now able to delete/edit the PRA Assessment/Re-Assessment.
- Program Analysts are now able to delete cases in Withdrawn status.
- Users are now able to update an exited participant's Waiver Factor in the program year the participant exited.
- Modified the Current/Exited Report to display the time in the Sub-Grantee column in the exported file.
- Program Analyst can view tasks for all users in the system.
- Users will no longer be blocked when adding an assignment to a case that was migrated from SPARQ.
- The header information is now populated on QPRs when there is no activity for the quarter.

## Known Issues

Issues introduced from deployment of release.

- **Tasks and Notifications:**
  - Currently there is an escalation issue with the Subgrantee and Grantee Administrator role for the IEP/Reassessment. The second escalation tasks are not populating for Subgrantee Admin and Grantee Admin roles for 10.5 months since IEP/reassessment.
- **Assignments by Host Agency Report:**
  - For certain selections for the filters on the Assignments by Host Agency Report, the User Interface produces no results and will not generate an export file. If both REPORT SUMMARY and ORGANIZATION SUMMARY filters are not selected, then the UI will only show blank content, even if there are active participants.
- **QPR Issues:**
  - Measure D.1a: The Number of Hours of Training (Current Quarter): if there are multiple assignments with training hours in a specific report period, then the measure is not calculated correctly.
  - Measures D.3b(1) and D.3b(2): Total Number of Participants Providing General/Elderly Community Service: if the participant has multiple assignments active during the same report period with different assignment types, then the measure is not calculated correctly.
  - Measure C.1d: If a participant is transferred during the reporting period, this measure currently increases by one (1) on the Nationwide QPR (the Internal QPR is working as expected).
  - Measures B1.1, B1.2, B1.4b and B2.1 are currently not rounding correctly on the Internal QPR. Measures B2.1 and B2.3 are currently not rounding correctly on the Nationwide QPR.
  - The title of measure D.2c (Number of Records without Credit in the Second Quarter After Exit) still needs a word wrap.
