## Release Notes – Hotfix 1.9.1

---

**Release Date: July 26, 2023**

GPMS Hotfix Release 1.9.1 will address enhancements, Production data changes and bugs discovered during the previous release.

### Enhancements

- Termination letter date can now be added independent of exit reasons and date of exit.

### Fixes

- Veteran Post 9/11 era is now not selected by default.
- Retired Sub-Grantees are no longer displayed in the sub-grantee dropdown for QPR generation.
- Removed Label "Count" from section B2.3
- Internal and Nationwide QPR Section B2
  - Rates reformatted to add percentage sign and round to one decimal point.
  - Median Earnings is now rounded to a whole number and a dollar sign added.
- Internal and Nationwide QPR Section B1
  - Service Level rates rounded to one decimal place.
  - Community Service rates were rounded to one decimal place.
  - Most in Need rates rounded to two decimal places.
  - Host Agency Survey goals and rates rounded to one decimal place.
  - Participant Survey goals and rates rounded to one decimal place.
- Internal and Nationwide QPR now reflects Number of Authorized positions instead of Allocated Authorized positions.
- Internal and Nationwide QPR Section B now displays a blank when there are no Goals and Targets populated in the system.
- Exit details are no longer missing when a participant is exited for exclusion.
- Fixed the issue where the Internal QPR was not generating for the current quarter.

## Known Issues

### Termination Letter Date

Users can now enter and save the date the termination letter was sent without entering any other exit information by doing the following:

- 1) Enter the date in the Termination Letter date field.
- 2) Click the save icon next to the Termination Letter date field.
- 3) Click on a Menu or Sub-Menu item to navigate away from the page.

**Note:** If you click the SUBMIT AND CLOSE button the required field on the exit page will be highlighted in red. Click on a Menu or Sub-Menu item to navigate away from the page.
