

Grant extensions prior to transfer if donor has more liberal IDL policy

Just a reminder to donor grantees about the practical implications of the following clause of the donor certification statement they see next to check box at the time they initiate a transfer:

The recipient grantee has also agreed to **the application of the more liberal of the two grantees' IDL policy for 90 days.**

This means (1) for any participant among your transferees who is due an extension in the program year in which the transfer occurs, and (2) your donor IDL is more liberal than the recipient IDL; you should complete the extension **PRIOR** to transferring them to the recipient.

As a reminder, participants do not have a right in SCSEP to an extension. Participants may be extended 365 days if: (1) you have completed any waivers that would qualify them for an extension under your IDL policy; (2) their DLD occurs in the current program year (however, for participants who will reach their duration limit in Q1 of the next program year, you can request an extension in Q4 of this program year as long as at least one waiver factor has been completed in Q4).
