Release Notes – Version 2.1

GPMS Release 2.1 will address Production data changes and bugs discovered during the previous release.

Release Number: 2.1

Resolved Issues

- The “Follow-up Outcome” field has now been renamed to “Referral Outcome.”
- Users can no longer enter “Durational Limit” as an Exit reason before the participant’s Durational Limit Date.
- The Last Update Date field is now required for the Waiver Factor regardless of which option is selected - YES or NO. A warning message will populate if no date is selected.
- Users will no longer receive Tasks to enter an Approved Break's Actual End Date after that field has been entered.
- Users will no longer receive Tasks related to deleted Approved Breaks.
- The calculation of “Days and Months Left in Program” has been revised and should now reflect the times remaining and or used in the program.

Known Issues

- Grantees who requested that the duplicate PIDs for given participants be deleted and the cases retained will notice that the duplicate PIDs were deleted, but not all the cases were retained. The missing cases will be updated in GPMS in a future release.
