

# SCSEP GPMS

## Release Notes – Version 2.3

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**Release Date: January 9, 2024**

GPMS Release 2.3 will address new features, enhancements, Production data changes and bugs discovered during the previous release.

### New Features

- New users can now submit a request to be added to the GPMS via the “SCSEP New User Enrollment” function located on the DOL landing page for the SCSEP Application.

### Enhancements

- The system will generate a message if a user enters a new case with the same application date as an existing case for a given participant.
- The Follow-Up Report has been modified to reflect the following:
  - When **Expired Follow-Up** is selected as a **Follow-Up Status**, the report will include only cases that are expired.
  - The **Placement Start** and **Placement End** dates have been added to the **Follow-Up Report Details** export.
  - Multiple **Follow-Up Statuses** can now be selected for a single Follow-Up report generation.
  - The completion dates for each follow-up have been added to the export file.
  - A participants’ phone number is no longer being displayed as the employers’ contact phone number.
- Date of Birth is now a required field on the **Enter Case Details** page.
- An **Exit Reason** is now required when the exit is marked as an **Exclusion at Exit**.
- When generating a state-level internal QPR for a National Grantee, the count of modified positions (MP) and authorized positions (AP) in the Grantee Overview section of the QPR is now the rolled-up total of APs and MPs of all active sub-grantees operating in that state.
- The value in the denominator of section B.1 Service Level for the state level QPR is the rolled-up total of MPs of all active sub-grantees operating in that state.
- The count of the APs and MPs in the Overview section on a sub-grantee level QPR is the AP and MP for that specific sub-grantee only.
- The value in the denominator of section B.1 Service Level is for a sub-grantee QPR is the MP of the individual sub-grantee only.
- Recipient grantees can now see the latest recertification record from the donor grantee.
- Users can now select their grantee/sub-grantee combination when using the “Participants Waiver Factor” function on the **Admin Console**.

- A notification will be sent to users if an eligible participant is in the system sixteen (16) days without an assignment based on the date the eligibility that was entered.
- The date/time stamp will no longer be displayed for recertifications.

## **Resolved Issues**

- All Paid Hours categories are now available after an approved break is deleted and the participant has an active status.
- The Error Evaluating UI Expression message will no longer be received when the Manage Eligibility Task Assignment function is invoked on the **Admin Console** page.
- Fixed the issue where users were unable to end an Assignment due to receiving an erroneous message stating that the participant is exited. The participant was in Active status.
- The Current/Exited report no longer lists an Approved Break for a participant whose break was deleted.
- The System Eligibility Determination process is now taking the income into account when the 6-month income is selected during recertification.
- The **10 days without Assignment/Break/Exit** notification will no longer be sent for participants on the waiting list.
- The dates for **Pre-Assessment Date** and **Program Overview Date** are now being saved on the **Other Enrollment Information>Program Introduction** page.
- Users should no longer receive tasks and notification for tasks that have been completed.
