Release Notes – Hotfix 2.3.1

Release Date: January 30, 2024

GPMS Release 2.3.1 addresses new features and bugs discovered during the previous releases.

New Features

- Participant email addresses have been added to the export feature of the Current/Exit Details Report.
- The Poverty Guidelines for 2024 have been added to GPMS.

Fixes

- Sections **D1a. Number of Hours of Training (Current Quarter)**, **D3a. Total Number of Participants Providing Community Service** and **D3b. Total Number of Hours Worked in Community Service**, of the Quarterly Progress Report (QPR), are no longer blank.
- The Numerator for the Low Literacy Skills **Most in Need (MIN)** measure on the QPR reflects the correct number. Double counting no longer occurs.
- The PROGRAM_EXIT_DATE is now being updated whenever there is an exit record in the CMS_SCSEP_CASE_EXIT table.
- For the **Community Service** measure in Section B of the QPR, the **L4Q** column will now be populated with “N/A”.
- Users can now access organizations from **Admin Console > Manage Organization and Contacts**. Users who reported that they were being redirected to the **Admin Console** after they clicked on an Agency ID should no longer experience this issue.
- Supportive services that were added to the placement record are now being saved.
- The latest version of the Urban -rural by zip code lookup file is in GPMS.
- The records for users with duplicate profiles, one of which is “unassigned”, have been updated.
- Existing tasks for breaks that have already been deleted have been removed from the task list.
- Users in Mariana Islands can now access their cases without receiving an UI error.

Known Issues

Poverty Threshold for 2024

The field **Number in Family** on the Eligibility screen accepts a maximum number of 35.

Correction to Release 2.3 Notes - Task and Notifications

The following fixes were made to Task and Notifications as part of 2.3:

1. Users are no longer receiving tasks related to IEP if an IEP Date has been entered in the record.
2. The “16 days without Assignment/exit” notification is now based on the date the Eligibility was entered. Applicants in Waitlist status will not generate this notification.
