Release Notes – Version 2.5

Release Date: March 22, 2024

GPMS Release 2.5 will address new features, enhancements, and bug fixes discovered during the previous release.

New Features

- Notifications will be sent to users in the Case Assigned to field:
 - Whenever a Durational Limit Extension must be updated. Notifications will be sent 45 days before the current extension expires and only for cases that are Active or Active-on-Break.
 - For physical exams when a case status is Active On break.
 - When a participant is determined recertification ineligible.

Enhancements

- The search results on the Cases tab can be sorted by participant's last name and then by first name.
- The introduction on the Participant Hours Report (PHR) has been updated to more closely reflect the content of the report.

Resolved Issues

- Negative follow ups will not be displayed for FU2's in the Follow Up Report.
- Grantees who do not give extensions will no longer receive notifications regarding extensions.
- Once the actual end date is entered for an approved break, the notification will be cleared from the Task and Notification list.
- The warning message regarding paid hours exceeding 325 hours will only be displayed when the hours actually exceed 325 hours.
- Participants who are not yet eligible for an extension will no longer appear in the Durational Limit Extension utility listing.
- Users will no longer be able to enter a break start date that is later than the assignment end date. If the user tries this combination, the system will issue an error message and the record will not be saved.
- Users can now retroactively add assignment start and end dates that are prior to any other assignments.

- A green check mark will not be displayed in the Waiver Updated column of the Waiver Factor Utility unless the waiver is updated for the program year. In addition, only active participants will be displayed in the utility.
- Tasks for durational limit will be cleared once the durational limit termination letter date is entered.
- Users should no longer see special characters (i.e. non-English characters) in the County name field.
- The application certification date is now being displayed on the eligibility screen.
- The columns on the details section of the “Modified Positions by State” ED Report have been repositioned to match the order of the columns in all the other ED reports.
- Participants who were previously on break, then returned from break, now appear in the search results for Active participants, not participants that are Active on Break.

Known Issues

None
