Release Notes – Version 2.7

Release Date: June 21, 2024

GPMS Release 2.7 addresses new features, enhancements, and bug fixes discovered during the previous release.

New Features

- When an assignment end date is changed to a previous quarter, the system will display a warning that the associated hours for quarters subsequent to the end date will be deleted.
- An optional field "Annual Program Overview" has been added on the Participant Required Actions page to capture annual updates where participants are reminded of policies and services.
- Users can now create cases that include Spanish accented characters in the participant's last name.
- On the View Frozen QPR Report module in the Admin Console, a message will now be displayed indicating that the QPR has not been frozen for an unfrozen QPR. This message will be displayed for both the Internal and Nationwide QPRs.
- When the Freeze QPR Report process is being executed in the Admin Console, users will be unable to view or generate ad-hoc QPRs.
- If updates need to be made to the data after a QPR has been frozen, the selected QPR can be unfrozen to allow changes. The user will receive a notification that the QPR has been unfrozen, and any needed changes can be made to the unfrozen QPR. Once the changes are complete, the QPR will be frozen again. Please note that this is a Program Analyst only function.
- A notification will be sent to the Program Analyst when a participant is enrolled in a county in which the grantee is not authorized to serve.
- A notification will be sent to "Assigned to" users annually when a participant's Waiver Factors have not been updated by May 1 in a given program year.
- The durational limit date (DLD) will now be updated when the assignment date is updated.
- GPMS has been updated with new zip codes and planning regions for Connecticut.
- Hyphenated or compound first names are now correctly capitalized.

Enhancements

• The participant ID (PID) has been added to the Break Extract.

- When clicking refresh on the Individual Participant export of the Participant Hours Report (PHR), the user will no longer be returned to the Home page. The download link will appear so that the report can be exported.
- Grammar and formatting have been corrected on the 90-day Durational Limit notification.
- Users will no longer receive a notification if the Physical Exam Date has been updated for the current program year.
- When a user exercises a Right of Return on the Placement page, the exit information will be deleted from the case.
- The label on the PRA screen has been updated from "Service Provider " to "Provider."
- The label "Workers' Comp Code" has been updated to "Workers' Comp Code at Host Agency."
- The label "Severely Limited Employment Prospects" has been updated to "Severely Limited Employment Prospects in Area of Persistent Unemployment."
- The verbiage for the authorization of recertifications and reason for ineligibility has been updated.
- The verbiage for the Contact Address in the Manage Organization function has been updated.
