Release Notes – Version 25.6

Release Date: March 20, 2026

These Release Notes provide information on GPMS Release 25.6 which addresses new features, enhancements, and bug fixes discovered during the previous release.

New Features

- Backend fields have been added for Total Hours of Paid Sick Leave for the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th Quarters of each program year in the data sent to WIPS.
- A backend field has been added for Total Hours of Paid Participant Required Action Activities in the data sent to WIPS.
- Several new features have been implemented related to Return to Service:
 - An optional comment field has been added to Return to Service to record notes about a participant's return to the program.
 - The Return to Service Date is now displayed in Participant History.
 - Labels have been updated from **Right of Return** to **Return to Service** in the GPMS user interface (UI).

Enhancements

- Users will no longer be allowed to edit an assignment date to a date that is after an approved break start date. Approved Breaks must begin after the assignment date
- Users will no longer be able to edit an Exit Date to a date after the Placement Start Date
- If an assignment date entered while there is an open break the user will receive the following message: **FYI: There is an open break for this case. Please click on the approved break tab to manage the break.**
- Tasks associated with a deleted case will be removed from the task dashboard

Known Issues

- Following the deployment of Release 25.6, some users with roles across multiple subgrantees experienced an issue where they were unable to access all cases associated with their assigned subgrantees and user roles on the **Cases** screen. The enhancement has been rolled back and the issue has been resolved.
