

SCSEP GPMS

Release Notes – Version 25.5

Release Date: January 28, 2026

These Release Notes provide information on GPMS Release 25.5 which addresses new features, enhancements, and bug fixes discovered during the previous release.

New Features

- Implements changes to the Right of Return (ROR) process in GPMS. Grantees received more information on changes to the ROR process in an email from the SCSEP National Office on January 29, 2026, titled “**Changes to Right of Return process in GPMS**”
- Users can now add ROR when a participant returns to service within 90 days by using **Modify Exit**.
- New Validations and Error Messages have been added to the system related to the changes in ROR process.
- Poverty Guidelines have been updated with the latest guidelines, with an effective date of January 12, 2026.

Enhancements

- Updates have been made to the WIPS submission, to more accurately capture all participants who were active within a given reporting period, if there is an exit date outside of that reporting period.

Fixes

- Users are no longer able to create multiple active cases for a single PID.
- Users will now see the **Save** button enabled when using the Manage Paid Hours Admin Console.
- Users will no longer experience issues with eligibility data not saving when cases are in **Pending** or **Pending Eligibility Determination statuses**.
- Grantee Administrators will no longer see cases from other grantees in the Durational Limit Utility.
- Users should no longer encounter cases in the UI where the **Case Assigned To** field is displayed as blank.
- Resolves an issue where some cases did not contain a value for “Number in Family”, which is a required field for GPMS and WIPS.
