

SCSEP GPMS

Release Notes – Version 26.1

Release Date: July 17, 2026

These Release Notes provide information about GPMS Release 26.1, which includes several enhancements and issue resolutions.

Enhancements:

- **Case Notes**
 - The Case Notes functionality has been updated to align with GPMS user roles. Users with permission to enter case data- including Case Managers, Supervisors, Subgrantee Administrators, and Grantee Administrators can now add and edit case notes. Subgrantee Administrators and Grantee Administrators can also delete case notes.
 - The Case Notes download file has been enhanced to remove text that was not intended to be displayed. Users will no longer see the phrase "**Retract Description Overflow**" in the Notes column of downloaded Case Notes files.
- **Admin Console**
 - The Admin Console has been enhanced for users with the **Read Only Restricted** role. These users now have access to the following functions:
 - View Frozen QPR Reports
 - Generate Internal QPR Reports
 - Participant Search

Resolved Issues:

- **WIPS QPR**
 - Resolved an issue that caused the **WIPS QPR** to undercount the Priority of Service/Waiver Factor Most-In-Need Characteristics **Formerly Incarcerated** for some grantees.
- **My Tasks**
 - Resolved an issue that caused some users to see **Pending Eligibility Approval** tasks for participants whose eligibility had already been approved and whose status was Active. These tasks will now be automatically cleared when the case status changes to **Eligible** or **Ineligible**.
 - Resolved an issue with **Approved Break** tasks that occurred when the **Expected End Date** was extended. Users will no longer receive tasks prompting them to

enter an End Date or Expected End Date when the Expected End Date has already been extended.

- **Internal QPR**
 - Updated the formatting of **Median Earnings Targets** in the Internal QPR. The Internal QPR now matches the formatting used in Frozen QPR reports for this measure.
- **Participant Information**
 - Removed a duplicate error message that appeared when an invalid email address was entered for a participant.
- **Other Issues**
 - Resolved an issue that caused the **Characteristics** checklist to appear incomplete when **Low Literacy** or **Limited English Proficiency** values were automatically populated by the system. This issue also prevented users from adding Assignments.
 - Resolved an issue that prevented users from initiating a transfer when a participant **Returned to Service** after previously having a placement with Placement Services. Users will no longer receive an error message requesting updates to Placement Services if an end date has already been entered.

Known Issues:

- An issue that caused the **WIPS QPR** to undercount the Priority of Service/Waiver Factor Most-In-Need Characteristics **Limited English Proficiency**, and **Low Literacy Skills** for some grantees has been partially resolved. Additional updates to this issue will be made in upcoming releases.
